About the Event:

Basketball is a sport that is played on a rectangular indoor court by two opposing teams of five players. Players employ their hands to manipulate the ball and accumulate points.

Details of the Tournament

The tournament will be carried out in accordance with the regulations of the Basketball Federation of India, unless otherwise altered in these rules.

The competition permits the use of rubber basketballs exclusively.

In the event of a tie between two or more teams in matches played on a league basis, the following procedure will be used to determine the winner:

- (a) Dual Tie: The team that has emerged victorious in the league matches against the other team shall be declared the winner.
- (b) Tie among multiple teams: In the event of a tie among more than two teams, the decision will be based on the following criteria: Points scored Points against. The team with the higher quotient will be declared the winner, and so forth. When determining the winner among three or more teams, only the points earned and conceded in the matches played between the tied teams will be considered.
- (c) If there is still a tie between two or more teams, it will be resolved using the following procedure:
- (d) The team with the fewest number of player fouls will be declared the winner. If the tie remains even after following the instructions mentioned in (i) above, the team with the fewest technical fouls will be declared the winner. (III) In the event that the tie remains unresolved after following the aforementioned steps (i) and (ii), the winner will be determined through a "Draw of Lots". If there is a tie in a match played on a knockout basis, an additional period of 5 minutes will be given until the tie is resolved.
- (e) Typically, a team should not be required to play more than two matches in a day. If, due to unavoidable circumstances, a team is required to play two matches in a single day, there must be a minimum of 2 hours between the end of the first match and the start of the second match. The tournament up to the zonal Semi-Final stage will be conducted using a knock-out format. Starting from the semi-final stage, a league system will be




- implemented. The Inter-department tournament will be played in a league-knockout format.
- (f) The maximum number of players allowed to represent a university is 12, and the team can receive a maximum of 12 merit certificates.
